





\$177,085 Youth Formation

Through the guidance of Fr. John David Matherne as Bishop's Liaison for Youth Formation, our parishes are receiving hands on support for the training and development of youth ministers in our parishes. As a key part of the mission of the Office of Parish Support our youth formation initiatives work within parishes and on a diocesan scale to:

- · Training small group leaders
- · Development of youth retreats such as Christian Leadership Institute, Junior High Faith Experience and more
- Certification for parish lay ministries
- · Developing a new approach to CCD and religious education for parishes

\$177,085 Office of Family Ministries

Office of Family Ministries works directly with parishes providing services and resources for programs that support couples, families and individuals by way of marriage preparation, remarriage preparation, marriage enrichment, grief support, and Natural Family Planning. Additionally, the Office of Family Ministries organizes our diocesan wedding anniversary prayer service and Respect Life initiatives including the Youth March for Life Pilgrimage to Washington, D.C. and help preserve the sanctity of all human life.

\$177,085 Adult formation

Over the past year, adult formation efforts have included: equipping 3-4 adults in every parish to become leaders of initiating a small group based discipleship process in their parish, offering 5 retreats focused on prayer and discernment for Parish Implementation Teams, producing over 60 short videos to help people understand about the Catholic faith and prayer. Producing the first of a 4 part discipleship video series called 'Art of Living', which is currently being piloted in parishes for the purpose of small group leader facilitation.
